The Confiscation Appeal has been filed against the order dated 19-09-2013 passed by the Lower Court of The District Forest Officer Ramgarh in Confiscation case no.- 46/2011 State Vrs Owner of Truck No.- JH-02L-1196.


There after case was admitted and Lower Court Record was called for.


In his petition appellants has stated that the Case for confiscation against him is not maintainable. It is further stated in the reply that the seized coal is legally purchased items from a bonafide coal traders M/S Adarsh coal sale & purchase Industrial Transporting Co-operative Society Ltd.Ghato Tand, Mandu, Distt. Ramgarh dated 19.05.2011 and had all valid & requisite papers. So appellants prayed that appeal may be allowed and lower court order be set aside.

From perusal of the case records, recommendation of Superintendent of Police Ramgarh, in Mandu Thana (West Bokaro O.P) Case no.- 86/2011, Dated 20-05-2011, it is clear that on 20-05-2011 Truck No.- JH-02L-1196 was found loaded with 15 Metric Tone illegal Coal without any valid papers from forest area. In the above facts and circumstances, I found no ground to interfere with the judgment of the Lower Court.

Hence the appeal is disallowed and Lower Court order is upheld. Case record to be submitted in record room.
