

The Designated Officer-cum-Addl.Chief Medical Officer, Ramgarh has issued a letter no.- 08, dated 08/11/2012 for initiation of Food Safety and Standers Act. 2006 against the accused Bharat Yadav, S/o Late Siyaram Yadav, M/S Yadav Dudh Bhandar, Bijulia, Ramgarh.

In his application dated 08/11/2012 Designated Officer-cum-Addl.Chief Medical Officer, Ramgarh has stated that the sample of Raw Milk bearing SI. & Code RMG-01. which had been Collected from the shop of Sri Bharat Yadav, S/o Late Siyaram Yadav, M/S Yadav Dudh Bhandar, Bijulia, Ramgarh, P.S. Ramgarh, District- Ramgarh has been declared Sub Standard by the Food Analyst vide his report No. 07 dated 21.01.2012

The above named accused person has thus contravened the rules and specified norms and lied down under the Food Safety and Standard Regulation 2011. He has rendered himself liable to be prosecuted u/s 51 of the Food Safety and Standards Act 2006. Which is in contravention of the rules and specified norms, laid down under the food safety Standard Regulation 2011 and liable to be prosecuted u/s 26 & 27 of the Food Safety and Standard Act 2006 and has prayed to punish the accused u/s 51 of the Act.


The Accused Bharat Yadav, S/o Late Siyaram Yadav, M/S Yadav Dudh Bhandar, Bijulia, Ramgarh in his show cause has denied the allegations made against him.


Heard both parties. As per report no.- 07 dated 21.01.2012 of the Food analyst State Food and Drug Laboratory, Namkum, Ranchi after due analysis of the sample of Raw Milk without Indication of the class of milk it does not conform the standard prescribed for Buffalo Milk. Hence it is Sub standards.

I found no evidence or material to disbelieve the report of the analyst, State Food and Drug Laboratory, Namkum, Ranchi. Accordingly the accused is found guilty U/S 51 of the Food Safety and Standards Act 2006 therefore he is liable for penalty of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) in sections. The accused petitioner is directed to deposit the amount of penalty within 90 days of the order, failing which necessary steps under section 96 of the Act shall be initiated against the accused petitioner.
